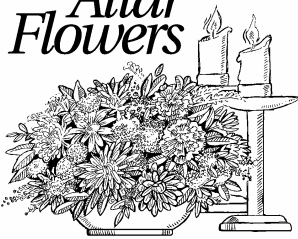
It's almost spring, which means it's time for our **Annual Easter Egg Hunt.**
